



# Conditions of participation

Posted on February 5, 2026

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Since 2025, the event has no longer been organized by us through an association, but as an independent event, so that individual clubs can hold or organize their own series at our event.

## ***General Conditions of participation:***

Road-legal vehicles or vehicles registered for road use abroad that have compulsory insurance, a valid MOT certificate, and all technical modifications entered in the vehicle registration document are eligible to participate. Dragsters or unregistered vehicles will be approved if they pass the technical inspection. All drivers/vehicle owners are responsible for the condition of their vehicles.

### **Approval to start on the quarter mile is given by:**

- legal age, 18 years of age (for Junior Nationals from 8 years of age or Junior Drag Bike Series from 6 years of age) or with a racing license from 16 years of age
- Proof of a driver's license or racing license
- successful completion of the paper acceptance process
- successful completion of the technical inspection of the vehicle for the respective class in accordance with its regulations (the regulations can be found further down this page)
- Participation in the driver briefing
- **ATTENTION! Diesel and electric vehicles are not permitted in the Jade Race!**

### **The following applies in principle:**

- Helmet compulsory, regardless of the time ridden
- Vehicle registration certificate (or vehicle documents) or chassis acceptance certificate
- Seat belts must comply with the manufacturer's specifications and be in good working order and designed according to class
- Battery mounting as standard and with battery terminal cover must be present
- If the battery is not fitted as standard in the rear, the battery must be installed in a leak-proof container and a circuit breaker must be fitted at the rear
- The fuel tank or the fuel lines must not be installed openly in the passenger compartment and must be sealed off by a fire protection wall or be located outside the vehicle interior.
- All brakes must be fully functional and all lines intact
- Wheel fastenings must be complete and undamaged, wheel covers must be removed (for the duration of the race)
- Clothing made of natural fibers, long trousers and long-sleeved shirts, sturdy shoes – also applies to start helpers! Attention, from 12 seconds please note the special requirements of the classes
- all four tires must be in good roadworthy condition



- Nitrous oxide: pressurized gas cylinder with proper attachment. Must be tested and valid for pressures up to 124 bar (DOT-1800). Pressure release outside the driver's cab.

**In addition to the basic rules mentioned above, the regulations of the United Drag Racing Association or other organizing clubs apply to the respective class. More detailed information can be found below under Rules and Regulations.**

The Jade Race Team (or its authorized assistants) reserves the right to disqualify or expel participants at any time in the event of subsequent unauthorized modifications to the vehicle, as well as for drivers who behave unsportingly or disregard regulations.

### Article 5 Regulations

The following regulations will be used:

- a. 1. [Technical Regelement UDRA](#)
2. [Event Reglement UDRA](#)
3. [Reglement from the DRU](#)
4. generally the international code of ethics and conduct in motorsport
- b. All entrants undertake to respect these regulations by participating in the event.

The organizer shall regulate the special features of the respective event in the invitation to tender. Unless otherwise stipulated in these regulations, the provisions of the above-mentioned regulations shall apply.

### Article 6 Route, classes, and conditions of the race

*Distance from start to finish line:* 402.33m  
*Length of the braking zone:* 600 m  
*Length of the additional safety run-off zone:* ca. 250 m  
*Track width:* 30 m

The distance for qualification and/or elimination can be shortened to 201.17m on the instructions of the race organizers.

In case of RAIN and the track is wet there will be NO race and NO restitution of the entry fee.

At least 6 cars or motorcycles are required for each class to take place. The organizer may redefine the limit for the number of vehicles in a class before the start of the event. This will be published on the homepage <https://jade-race.com> prior to the event.

The qualifying time for the ST, SLB, HS, and FWD groups is the fastest time achieved.

The qualifying time for the E.T. Handicap Racing classes (TCP, SPRO, SOET) is the smallest positive difference from the self-selected index.

Die Qualifikationszeit für die XO Klasse ist die geringste positive und negative Differenz zum selbst gewählten Index.

The qualifying time for classes SC, DI, and SCB is the smallest positive difference from the group-specific index.

In the Junior Dragster (JD) and Junior Drag Bike (JDB) groups, the qualifying time is the best reaction time at the start.

If more than one qualifying run is completed, the driver must ensure that a lane change is made for each additional qualifying run. For example: 1st run -> left lane / 2nd run -> right lane or vice versa.

The number of vehicles listed below may take part in training and races:

- Training all approved vehicles
- Race all vehicles with at least one (1) qualifying run

The "TRUE START" rule is applied. Any other rule may be adapted by means of an implementation provision.

The participant is responsible for affixing the start number (according to the regulations). The participant allows the organizer to use pictures of his person and his vehicle for any kind of publication.

#### **Article 7 Technical Inspection and Parc Fermé**

The inspection takes place in the designated technical inspection area at the end of the LineUp. Starts on:

- Friday, July 17, 2026, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Saturday, July 18, 2026, 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

After technical scrutineering, the driver receives a sticker which must be affixed in the top left-hand corner of the windshield. Without this sticker, the driver will not be authorised to start.

#### **Article 8 Nomination: Deadline for submissions and acceptance**

As stated on the registration form (ticket shop/homepage), the registration deadline is June 28, 2026, at midnight, and the entry confirmation will be sent out before the race. (Under special circumstances, the sending of the entry confirmation may be postponed).

The required fee (see registration form and/or confirmation of participation) must be paid by midnight on June 28, 2026 (registrations without this fee are invalid).

*The participation fees for the race at JadeWeserAirport in Mariensiel will be: Admission ticket per event. (Including driver ticket and electricity) €250,-*

*Double entry - Entry of the same driver in two race classes: N/A*



*Junior Dragsters/Bikes: without mechanic ticket*

#### **Article 9 Paper acceptance/administrative control/race office**

The race office will be located at the organizer's address until midnight on July 15, 2026. From 9:00 a.m. on July 16, 2025, it will be located at JadeWeserAirport.

Collection of documents/administrative control starts on:

- Thursday, July 16, 2026, 12:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Friday, July 17, 2026, 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Saturday, July 18, 2026, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

The participant (applicant) or the driver and, if applicable, their guardian must be present at the specified place and time for the administrative/license check and then for the technical inspection. The following documents of the participant and the driver must be presented at the administrative check:

- If not already sent, the signed liability waiver

At the administration control you will receive the "Pre and Post Scrutineering Forms".

For underage participants, a "parental consent form" must be presented at the administrative check if the parents are not present at the event.

If the participant (applicant) is not present at this event, a written authorization must be presented by the driver at the administrative control.

#### **Article 10 Schedule: Timed exercises, preliminary tests, and races**

#### **Article 11 Protests**



Protests must be addressed/submitted to the race director or the chair of the arbitration panel. In the absence of the chair of the stewards, such protests must be submitted to one of the other stewards or, in their absence, to the race director or his assistant, if available, or to the race director or his assistant, if available.

**Protest fee: € 500,-**

Appeal Fee: € 1.800,-.

### **Article 12 Boxing regulations**

Maximum speed: The Maximum speed in the Paddock and Pits area is: 5 km/h.

Refueling, changing engine oils or lubricants and coolants on the racing vehicles is only permitted in the pits. A liquid-absorbing tarpaulin under the entire vehicle is mandatory.

The driver is responsible for disposing of fuel, engine oil, lubricants, and coolants. He must have appropriate containers ready and take them home or bring them to a specialized disposal company himself. Failure to comply will result in disqualification from the competition and a penalty fee of €500.00.

Drilling holes in the ground in the paddock is strictly prohibited! Failure to comply will result in disqualification from the competition and a penalty fee of 250.00 Euro per hole drilled.

### **Article 13 Drivers' meeting**

A driver briefing will take place in writing before the start of the event. Each driver will receive an email with the briefing documents attached. During the technical inspection, the driver must confirm in writing that they have read, understood, and accepted these documents.

A driver briefing will only take place if necessary. Communicated by the track announcer and on the official notice board on the homepage <https://jade-race.com>.

### **Article 14 Technical Inspection**

If the vehicle is classified as non-compliant or unsafe, the driver may not take part in either the practice session or the race. It is possible to carry out a second inspection. If the vehicle is classified as compliant during the inspection, the driver will receive a non-removable sticker. Only this sticker indicates that the vehicle is authorized to participate in this event.

### **Article 15 Fuel/Fuel Control/Doping and Alcohol Testing**

Carried out in case of suspicion or at random.

### **Article 16 Driver tickets/mechanic tickets/passes**



Any person (drivers, team members, officials, press, etc.) entering the pit area must have their ticket/ID visible at all times and wear a high visibility vest/appropriate high visibility clothing/official team clothing so that the inspecting officials can easily see if that person has the correct ticket/ID at all times. If a person does not have their ticket/ID visible or is not wearing a high-visibility vest, they will not be allowed to enter the pit area.

#### **Article 17 Radio communications**

Not allowed.

#### **Article 18 Passengers and third parties as drivers**

Under no circumstances is it permitted to transport a passenger in a vehicle or to drive a third person in a vehicle on the track or to participate in a race or training session. Es gelten die Regeln der United Drag Racing Association. Passengers may be permitted in certain cases by the race organizers or the race director.

There are exceptions in certain cases when: The race director or race official has given permission to take a person other than the driver in the vehicle onto the track or to allow a third person to take a vehicle onto the track for a test or demo run.

If this is permitted, then only with the written permission of the race director or the race director and the participant who is sitting in the vehicle or driving the vehicle.

The participant declares that the organization or individuals are not responsible for any damages and that these are caused at their own responsibility and risk with the approval of the race director under the conditions specified in the liability waiver.

Participation takes place under the supervision and strict instruction of the race director or C.O.C.
